

Free COVID-19 Testing

June 5 and 6, 2020 | 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

To increase COVID-19 testing opportunities for minorities and other vulnerable populations, the Herbert Henderson Office of Minority Affairs, WV Department of Health and Human Resources, WV National Guard and local health departments are providing FREE, optional testing for residents in counties with high minority populations and evidence of COVID-19 transmission. This testing will occur on June 5 and 6, 2020, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., at the following locations.

This testing is available to all individuals in the selected counties, including asymptomatic individuals. Proof of insurance is NOT required.

Identification, such as a driver's license or proof of address, will be required to be tested. Those under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

NOTE: Testing will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis.
