The Bridgeport Planning Commission met Monday, May 5, 2014, at 4:00 p.m. in Bridgeport City Hall, 515 West Main Street, with the following members present: President Rodney Kidd, Vice President Doug Gray, City Council Representative Robert Greer, Jolie Carter, Patrick Jeffers, and Randy Spellman. Member Philip Freeman was absent.


The meeting was called to order by President Kidd and officers were elected for 2014 as follows: Motion was made by Jolie Carter, seconded by Robert Greer to nominate Rodney Kidd for president. Motion to re-elect Rodney Kidd for president was unanimously approved.


President Rodney Kidd nominated Doug Gray for vice president, seconded by Patrick Jeffers. Motion to re-elect Doug Gray for vice president was unanimously approved.

Minutes of the November 4, 2013 Planning Commission were unanimously approved as presented on a motion by President Kidd, seconded by Member Carter.

Under new business was to consider the preliminary plat request of Anne Faris, for a five lot subdivision. A scaled drawing was presented to the members showing Harrison County Tax Map 24-26, Parcel 329-13 located along Conifer Drive at South Hills. Randy Spellman described that the entrance to the five lots would come off of Conifer Drive. He also explained that the lots meet all city requirements and the lot sizes that range from .76 to 1.24 acres were in compliance. After general discussion, the preliminary plat was approved on a motion made by President Kidd, seconded by Patrick Jeffers and unanimously approved.

Meeting adjourned at 4:15 p.m. on a motion by Member Carter, seconded by Member Gray and duly approved.
